Idaho State Board of Education
(In Trust For Idaho State University)

is entitled to a Land Patent pursuant to the Act of September 1, 1888 (25 Stat. 452) and pursuant to the Settlement Agreement and Stipulation for Order of dismissal between the United States, Shoshone-Bannock Tribes and Defendants State of Idaho, State Board of Education and Regents of the University of Idaho and Idaho State University reached in United States vs. Colaianni, et al, No. 82-4193 (D. Idaho) for land within the Townsite of Pocatello, Idaho, described as:

- Lot 6 of Block 16;
- Lots 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Block 63;
- Lots 7, 8 and 9 of Block 194,

according to the approved Plat of Survey of said Townsite on file in the Bureau of Land Management.

NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES, unto the above-named claimant the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant, their successors or assigns forever;

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING TO THE UNITED STATES a right-of-way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States pursuant to the Act of August 30, 1890, 26 Stat. 391; 43 U.S.C. 945.

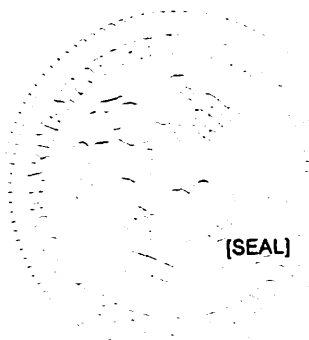
