Thank you for downloading ArcGIS Pro software using our Software Request form.

To begin, unzip the downloaded files to a folder on your computer. To do this:

- Right click and choose to Extract All.

At ArcGIS 3.0, Microsoft .Net Runtime needs to be installed before installing ArcGIS Pro.

To install Microsoft .Net Runtime:

- Find the newly extracted Microsoft dotNet runtime folder.
- Start the installation by double clicking windowsdesktop-runtime-6.0.6-win-x64.exe.
- Follow the installation wizard to install Microsoft .Net runtime.

To install ArcGIS Pro:

- Find the newly extracted ArcGISPro folder.
- Start the installation by double clicking ArcGISPro.msi
- Follow the installation wizard to install ArcGIS Pro.

To install ArcGIS Pro Help:

- Find the folder ArcGISProHelp
- Start the installation by double clicking ArcGISProHelp.msi
- Follow the installation wizard to install ArcGIS Pro Help.

The following installations are optional.

To install the ArcGIS Pro Data Interoperability extension:

- Find the folder ArcGISProDataInterop
- Start the installation by double clicking DataInteropPro.msi
- Follow the installation wizard to install ArcGIS Pro Data Interoperability extension.

To install the ArcGIS Pro Coordinate System Data:

- Find the folder ProCoordinateSystemsData.
- Start the installation by double clicking ProCoordinateSystemsData.msi
- Follow the installation wizard to install ArcGIS Pro Coordinate Systems Data.

Patches for this software are also available in the shared Google Drive and will have a .msp extension.

Once installed, open the ArcGIS Pro software. You will be asked to enter credentials. This is not your ISU username and password. The login credentials you will use here are your ArcGIS Online credentials. This requires an ArcGIS Online account with sufficient licensing permissions.
